As we finish off the school year, I want you to be aware of a few things. As you know, each middle school student was issued a chromebook. It was just announced to us that each middle school student will be allowed to keep this chromebook until they graduate from LPHS or leave the district. If you feel like they may not keep it safe over the summer, you may want to keep it safe somewhere and not let them use it. We can also work with you if you need other arrangements for safe keeping.

Online students can walk or be driven to the school to drop off books at an outside table with staff. Their name will be marked off as returned. Any books not returned, will be entered as a debt on their student account. Books will be accepted between the hours of 8:00- 10:00 and 11:00-2:00

We have printed all of the student awards for Honor Roll and Attendance. If your child received an award, it will be mailed home next week. Additionally, I will be sending a separate email to you with a link to view the video we have put together to recognize the student's achievements. Report card grades will be entered and available to view in Parent and Student Connect on June 12th. Paper report cards will not be mailed home.
